Library staff is not available to help anyone configure their laptop or PDA to access the wireless network or provide any technical assistance if difficulties occur. Staff will verify that the network is on and working.

Wireless printing is available through the eprint app. Users may save their work to a flash drive or other peripheral device and use the wired public access computers to print, or users can email documents to the library's institutional email and staff will print it off as soon as it is possible.
